

GREENE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

SEPTEMBER 6, 2024 CALLED MEETING

Call to Order: Chairman Usry called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. and led the invocation, specifically mentioning the Eddy family as well as those suffering from the shooting at Apalachee High School.

Roll Call: Commissioners Deering, Smith, Lindsey, Filice, and Chairman Usry were present. Also present was County Manager Byron Lombard.

Consideration of a Resolution Establishing Millage Rates and Fees for the 2024 Tax Digest: The Commissioners received background information that the establishment of millage rates and fees was necessary to submit certain information to the Georgia Department of Revenue and to keep tax bills on schedule. Commissioner Smith motioned to approve Resolution Number 2024.9.6(a) that establishes millage rates and fees for all tax districts for the 2024 Tax Digest, and to waive the reading of the Resolution. Commissioner Deering seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Consideration of a Resolution to Adopt the Fiscal Year 2025 Budgets: The Commissioners received background information that the Fiscal Year 2025 Budget Process has been completed and the necessary legal steps, including the required public hearing, have been undertaken. Commissioner Lindsey motioned to approve Resolution Number 2024.9.6(b) adopting the Fiscal Year 2025 Budgets for all Funds of the County, and to waive the reading of the Resolution. Commissioner Filice seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Consideration of an Alcoholic Beverage License Request – Table at the Lake: The Commissioners received background information that the new owner and operator of The Grill at Lake Oconee restaurant is seeking a similar alcoholic beverage license as the previous owner. Commissioner Filice motioned to approve an alcoholic beverage license for consumption on the premises for liquor, beer, and wine, for Oliver Restaurants, LLC, doing business as Grill 11, located at 1100 Parkside Main, Suite 102, Greensboro, Georgia, in the name of Kristy Oliver as the holder of the License. Commissioner Deering seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Consideration of an Alcoholic Beverage License Request – Table at the Lake: The Commissioners received background information that Table at the Lake desires to obtain an Alcoholic Beverage License for retail package sales of beer and wine. Commissioner Filice motioned to approve an alcoholic beverage license for retail sales of beer and wine, for The Table at the Lake Operating Company, LLC, doing business as Table at the Lake, located at 1010 Cowles Clinic Way, Greensboro, Georgia, in the name of Jon F. Altizer-Bieger as the holder of the License. Commissioner Lindsey seconded. Commissioner Smith asked about what sales he hoped to undertake, and the applicant stated the license was sought so that they could sell wine when undertaking wine dinner events. Motion carried unanimously.
