1. Consideration of an Appointment to the Division of Family and Children Services - Greene County Advisory Board

District 1 Commissioner Walker-Deering motioned to reappoint Jan Thurmond to the Division of Family and Children Services — Greene County Advisory Board for a five-year term starting July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2031. District 4 Commissioner Blanton seconded. Motion passed 5 - 0.

2. Consideration to an Amendment to the Rules of Order

There was general discussion that the changes proposed are meant to address the order and public comment during regular meetings. District 1 Commissioner Walker Deering motioned to approve Ordinance 2026.6.9 amending the Rules of Order, noting the clarifications discussed, and to waive the reading of the Ordinance. District 3 Commissioner Lindsey seconded. Motion passed 5 - 0.

3. Consideration of Budget Adjustments

District 3 Commissioner Lindsey motioned to approve the budget adjustments for FY2026 for insurance claims and associated expenditures and for overages due to increased costs and grant proceeds as prepared by the Finance Department. District 4 Commissioner Blanton seconded. Motion passed 5 - 0.

County Manager Crawley and Finance Manager Amanda Smith gave a presentation to the Board regarding FLOST versus LHOST. Following public comment, Chairman Usry invited questions from the audience. No official action was taken.
